STATE DEPARTMENT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION INTRODUCES FREE INTEREST CHECKING ACCOUNT CHOICES

Washington, DC. – State Department Federal Credit Union now offers interest and high interest checking accounts to its members. No monthly service fees are required. Both accounts require a minimum balance, but do not penalize members for dropping below the minimum balance.

The Advantage Checking Account, a \$5,000 minimum balance account, includes customized checks, online banking, web bill pay, eStatements, telephone banking and more, all free of charge.

Those who can maintain a minimum balance of \$25,000 can take advantage of the Privilege Checking Account. In addition to the benefits offered to Advantage account members, Privilege account members receive a monthly reimbursement of up to \$50 for surcharge fees associated with the use of ATMs outside of the SDFCU network.
