Our records show that you have a State Department Federal Credit Union Automated Teller Machine (ATM) card.

You will soon receive your new ATM card. It will replace the card you have been using. Please note your current card is green in color and the new one will be blue. Once you have received the new card, destroy any other SDFCU ATM cards you may have.

In an effort to relieve the stress of memorizing a new PIN number, we have been able to keep the PIN number the same as the current card you are using. For your convenience, a copy of the system generated PIN will also be mailed. If you selected your PIN in the past and wish to continue using that PIN, you may stop by any of our branch offices for assistance to re-select it.

If you recently received or applied for our Visa Check Card, you may still receive a replacement ATM card which will only be valid for 60 days from the date of the Visa Check Card was issued. You may contact our office to verify the status of your account..
