

Visa Check Card Reissue

Many of our members have a State Department Federal Credit Union VISA Check Card. We will be reissuing these cards to provide increased security and to take advantage of future enhancements.

When will the new card be mailed?

Your new card will be mailed no later than June 2002. For security purposes, your VISA Check Card will not be active until you call a toll-free telephone number to activate it.

Will my current VISA Check Card still work until I receive the new card?

Your current card and PIN will expire 60 days from the reissue date. After you receive your new card, please activate it by calling the toll-free telephone number and destroy your old card.

Will creditors and vendors who automatically debit my account receive my new account number?

No, you will have to contact them with your new account number.

Will the new VISA Check Card look different?

The new Visa Check Cards will have our web address (in blue ink) - www.sdfcu.org - on the back of the card. The front of the cards will look the same.
